Summer Placements	Child up to 2 years	One week each month plus one weekend	
	Child aged 2 thru 12 years	Alternating 2 week periods	
	Child 13 or older	Noncustodial parent has 4 consecutive weeks beginning at 12 noon on the 2d Sunday following the ending of the school year. The custodial parent does not exercise any placement during this 4 week block. Weekends will again alternate after the 4-week block.	
	Family with children in more than one age group	Alternating 2 week periods	
Priority of Placements	Holiday, parent's days and birthday placements have precedence over bi-weekly, mid-week, school holiday vacations, and summer placements. Week-end and mid-week placements are suspended during summer placements except as noted specifically in the summer placement schedule.		
Flexibility and Reasonability	This schedule is intended to be a <i>minimum</i> schedule of placement. The parties are free to mutually agree to modify the schedule to meet their needs or the needs of their children. Also, the parties must be flexible to accommodate the other parent in terms of the beginning and ending times of placements. Any attempt to rigidly or inflexibly enforce the times without consideration to the other parent or children will be considered by the court as poor parenting and a violation of the spirit of this schedule.
